The Resolution was read, and the Board members signed it and it will be sent to the Ottawa County Auditor.

The board reviewed the 2021 Audit Report. The Port Authority is required to use Purchase Orders with every expenditure per the ORC 5705.44. Rosann has started that procedure.

Information for the next tax levy by the PIB Port Authority is to be submitted in 2023. It was recommended by the Ottawa County Auditor that the Port Authority have a Replacement Levy to capture all the new real estate properties developed.

The Port Authority Tax Assessment was reimbursed except for the Put-in-Bay water line assessment of \$401.42 per year. The assessment will be completed year ending 2026.

Marine/Harbor Report:

A SLL application was submitted by Jenna Gonzalez at 275 Mikes Drive for the completion of a new armor stone evertment. The board reviewed the plans. A Resolution needs to be approved to submit to ODNR and USACE.

Airport:

The North Bass Poisonous Hemlock spraying will be done by the Ottawa County Soil and Water. They may charge us for the Roundup for \$50-60. It is possible they may be able to fund it as well. They will advise. The Port has set up a reservation with Miller Boat Line ferry for their next Fall trip to North Bass Island. The Port Authority will pay the ferry fee.

Tucker Kepford has inquired about building a hangar at Middle Bass Airport. A sample lease agreement and hangar specifications were sent to him.

The parcel is across the street from the airport ramp and runway. A building height restriction is required so close to the airport surfaces.

Fremont Fence will be making many repairs to the Put-in-Bay Airport fence, they had to update the pricing. The new estimate is \$4,236.
